

THE HISTORY OF ADANA ANATOLIAN HIGH SCHOOL(ALA)

Adana Anatolian High School, located in Adana, Turkey was founded in 1975-76 academic school year. Since its establishment, it has continued to be one of the most prominent and prestigious schools in Turkey.

Adana Anatolian High School started education on October 16, 1975 in the two-story historical mansion. The school moved to the second building in 1978, later to the third building in 1984 and then located in this building for three years. After that, the school moved to the fourth building in 1978 and it has been situated in this building since then.

In 1982, Adana Anatolian High School men's volleyball team used 'ALA' on their jerseys for the first time and as a consequence the school implemented ALA as the abbreviation of the school.

1. Hüseyin SABIRLI (October 23, 1975 to October 21, 1977)

Mr. SABIRLI was the first principal of the school and he was math teacher.

2. Mustafa SOFU (November 17, 1977 to April 15, 2008)

He governed for 31 years.

3. Hasan KAZAN (February 19, 2009 to November 24, 2009 – May 4, 2011 to 2014)

4. Erdal SEVİM (September 19, 2014 – March 2020)

5. Muharrem YANARATES (March, 2020 -)
